In prayer, we continue to seek God's face and desire His power and proclaim His promises. Prayer is reaching out after the unseen; fasting is letting go of all that is seen and temporal. Fasting helps express, deepen, confirm the resolution that we are ready to sacrifice anything, even ourselves to attain what we seek for the kingdom of God.

Suggested Plan:

- Choose a day of the week to fast (whole day or portion thereof) during the month.
- Set aside 15 minutes each day to pray for our church – and specifically, set aside Wed mornings (7 AM) or evenings (9 PM) where we are ALL can pray at the same time for our church, our mission, our unity, and for one another.
- Make use of our War Room (Prayer Room). It is always open and ready. Come and pray BEFORE or AFTER church on Sunday morning. Come during the week.
- Attend our monthly PRAYER VIGIL on the last Friday of the month. Our next vigil is March 31 at 7 pm.
